

The Monona Grove School District serves a middle-class, suburban population of approximately 2900 students. Pre-kindergarten through 12th grade students come from the neighboring communities of Monona and Cottage Grove, both located just outside the city of Madison. The district is comprised of six schools - two primary schools, two intermediate schools, one middle school and one high school. The ethnic population of the students is: 89%-White, 3%-Asian, 5%-Black, 3%-Hispanic, and <1% American Indian. Approximately 12% of the student population has been identified with special education needs. Approximately 9% of the students qualify for free or reduced lunch.

The district is guided by the mission statement "*Building a Community of Learners*" and is committed to providing quality education that meets the needs of all students, including programs for special needs students, gifted and talented students and English language learners.
