VOCATIONAL EDUCATION

Given that gainful employment is an essential component of every person's life, it follows that each student should have some set of skills that will allow him/her to enter gainful employment and earn a respectable livelihood or at least sustenance while pursuing advanced education.

With this statement in mind, vocational education programs must take their proper place among the district's curricular offerings. One of the goals of this district is to provide a complete program of vocational education to all students who want or can benefit from such a program regardless of their sex, race, religion, national origin, color, ancestry, creed, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation, handicap or physical, mental, emotional or learning disability.

Vocational education faculty shall work to maintain and improve vocational opportunities within the present vocational disciplines; to reduce sex stereotyping; to improve the content, methodology, resources and opportunities within those disciplines; to improve course opportunities available to students with disabilities; and to improve curricular coordination with area schools and technical institutes.
