Board Policy 342.1

PROGRAMS FOR CHILDREN WITH DISABILITIES

The district shall provide a free appropriate public education to resident children with disabilities, as defined by state law, ages three to 21. The district shall provide supportive and related services needed to assist an individual child to benefit from special education. The related services shall consist of transportation and such developmental, corrective and other supportive services as are required to assist a disabled child to benefit from special education and includes speech pathology and audiology, psychological services, and physical and occupational therapy. Related school services also include health services, social work and counseling services.

Special education and supportive and related services shall be provided either locally or through agreements with other school districts or agencies and shall be provided in accordance with state and federal law.

The Monona Grove School District shall not discriminate in programs for children with disabilities on the basis of sex, race, religion, national origin, color, ancestry, creed, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation, age, homeless status, handicap or physical, mental, emotional or learning disability.
