## Board Policy 342

### SPECIAL AND ALTERNATIVE EDUCATION PROGRAMS

The Monona Grove School District shall strive to meet the educational needs of all district students by helping each student develop to his/her maximum potential and by providing educational programs that reflect a variety of learning rates and styles.

The Board recognizes that alternative instructional programs and services may occasionally be called for to meet the individual needs of certain students. Therefore, the Board shall provide such programs and services in accordance with laws, regulations and district policies and procedures.

The Monona Grove School District shall not discriminate in special and alternative education programs on the basis of sex, race, religion, national origin, color, ancestry, creed, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation, age, homeless status, handicap or physical, mental, emotional or learning disability.
