Administrative Rule 412.1

DEFINITION OF FULL-TIME STUDENT

Students in the Monona Grove School District shall be considered full-time if they can be classified into at least one of the following categories:

1. An elementary or middle school student who is scheduled for the full school day.
2. A high school student must have a class load of 5.5 credits for the freshman year and six credits for each of the following years. A student involved in a school-sponsored and supervised work experience program at the 12th grade level shall have the work experience credits count toward the required minimum credits for full-time attendance.
3. A high school student carrying less than the minimum number of credits if such class load is medically prescribed and attendance is approved by the High School Principal.
4. A student with disabilities who has been assessed by an individualized education program (IEP) team and has been prescribed a program.
5. A student participating in an alternative educational program or other program or curriculum modifications approved by the student's parent/guardian and school officials.
6. A district resident attending a school in another public school district on a full-time basis under the state's public school open enrollment program.
