Board Policy 424

ADMISSION OF ADULT STUDENTS

A resident of the Monona Grove School District who is over 20 years of age may audit a course in the district provided the following conditions are met:

1. The course is an appropriate offering for other than high school-age people.
2. There is space available in the course for additional persons.
3. The person has the appropriate prerequisites to audit the course.
4. The person commits to regular attendance and abides by all school rules and regulations.
5. The person pays for any supplies.
6. A conference between the teacher and adult student is held to discuss objectives.
7. The person does not require a disproportionate amount of the teacher's time.
8. The person's attendance does not interfere with the students of school age

Admission shall be based on the recommendation of the building principal and approval by the Superintendent.
