Board Policy 434

CLOSED CAMPUS

Providing a comprehensive educational program of learning experiences for students throughout the school day is regarded by the Board of Education as a fundamental responsibility of the school at all levels. Therefore, except as otherwise provided, students shall not be permitted to leave the school during the school day without the permission of the building principal or designee. High school students may leave the school and school premises during their lunch period.

Additionally, high school students who have met the established criteria as defined in the student handbook, which would qualify them for open campus privileges, may leave school and school premises during the school day. Students under the age of 18 must have parental permission to leave campus during the school day if they qualify for open campus privileges.
