Board Policy 441.2

### **STUDENT REPRESENTATION TO THE BOARD**

The Board of Education recognizes the unique perspective held by students on issues impacting the District. Therefore, the Board shall appoint a student representative to the Board. This student (or his/her alternate) shall represent the views of students enrolled in the District on agenda items discussed at regularly scheduled Board meetings.

The student representative shall:

- 1) not be able to vote on any of the issues before the Board; he she serves in an advisory capacity only.
- 2) be excluded from executive sessions of the Board.
- 3) attend all regularly scheduled Board meetings and sit at the Board table. He/she shall be free to enter into discussions or answer questions in the same manner as elected Board members.
- 4) be encouraged to attend Board Committee meetings when appropriate.
- 5) represent all students in the District.
- 6) be a junior or senior at the high school and begin his/her annual term on August 1<sup>st</sup>.
- 7) have all Board agendas and informational papers mailed to him/her.
