Board Policy 451.1

USE OF HEALTH INSURANCE PROCEEDS

Parents/guardians of all students shall be requested to use their health insurance to support the provision of health care services by the district. These services shall include medical diagnostic/consultation evaluation, allied diagnostic evaluations and allied treatment services. The allied treatment services may include, but shall not be limited to, psychological, social work, speech/language, physical therapy, occupational therapy, audiological and vocational rehabilitation services.

Health care services shall be provided at no direct cost to parents/guardians. The district shall pay the insured's deductible and co-payment costs in accordance with their health care plan, as applicable, to claims filed for services provided by the district.

Parent/guardian consent to use his/her insurance shall be requested with the understanding that services will be provided whether consent is given or withheld.

A disclosure statement shall be issued with the insurance claim to the insurance carrier.

Reimbursement receipts shall be used to supplement the continued provision of these services to the district's students.

Service reimbursement receipts shall not exceed \$5,000 per year for service to any individual students.
