Board Policy 460

STUDENT AWARDS

The Board recognizes the appropriateness of giving recognition to students for scholarship and for distinguished service and significant achievement in the activity program of the school.

The building principal shall be responsible for establishing standards, criteria and guidelines for developing, administering and evaluating a student awards program in his/her building. The relationship between each award included in the program and the educational philosophy and goals of the school shall be clearly established.

The building principal shall review and evaluate all award programs proposed by non-school donors. Approval shall be given only to those programs that are consistent with Board policy and the standards, criteria and guidelines established by the principal and shall be given in accordance with this policy.

Any proposed district-wide awards must be reviewed and approved by the Superintendent/designee.

The Monona Grove School District shall not discriminate in the acceptance and administration of gifts, bequests, scholarships and other aids, benefits or services to students from private agencies, organizations or persons on the basis of sex, race, religion, national origin, color, ancestry, creed, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation, handicap or physical, mental, homeless status, emotional or learning disability. Discrimination complaints shall be processed in accordance with established procedures.
