Board Policy 470

STUDENT FEES AND FINES

The Board shall furnish, materials of instruction for the basic educational program of the district. Students shall not be required to use personal funds to purchase textbooks or basic materials for the required curriculum.

The Board may authorize minimal fees for materials, which are used in activities beyond the basic educational program for rental of school-owned property and for other purposes as the Board may properly determine.

Students are expected to pay for classroom materials that are used to produce articles having intrinsic and/or utilitarian value for the student. Charges shall be made to fully cover the costs to the school in such cases.

Summer school fees shall be based upon materials and service costs in excess of per student costs of regular year classes in the same departments and subject to state law and regulations.

Students who are transported to interscholastic contests, as spectators, shall be charged a fee based upon the principle of full recovery for the district. A similar policy shall dictate charges made for all saleable supplies provided for students.

Students who cannot afford to pay for fees or for approved materials shall be exempted from such payment by the building principal and/or designee. Information regarding such exemptions shall be kept confidential by all teachers and principals.

Students shall be expected to reimburse the district for lost or damaged instructional media center materials, textbooks, and equipment in an amount not to exceed the undepreciated value of such items.
