Board Policy 621

BUDGET PLANNING

Prior to the adoption of the budget, the Board shall study the district's programs in its relation to the present and future needs of the students and the community. In order to make the budget a comprehensive reflection of the financial needs of the district's programs, steps shall be taken to involve representatives of the professional and support staff and the administrative staff in the budget development process. The procedure for the involvement of these representatives shall be developed and implemented by the Superintendent or designee with the approval of the Board.

The Superintendent or designee shall annually submit a calendar for budget development to the Board for approval. In order to ensure full consideration, recommendations by Board and staff committees for new and/or enhanced programs should be submitted by January 31 each year.

The budget development process shall include a minimum of three hearings for public input.
