Board Policy 656

GRANTS

Applications may be made for grants provided that the conditions of acceptance are in accordance with the policies of the Board, the objectives of the district, and all applicable laws.

In the seeking of grants, the Superintendent shall be guided by these guidelines:

1. The Superintendent shall retain direction, supervision and control over all phases of any project.
2. Project proposals shall include an accurate picture of the phase-out schedule and the district commitments for continuance. The district shall comply with all requirements involved in the acceptance of the project and the projected continuance.
3. The proposed project shall not cause an excessive burden to the existing or any future budgets and financing shall be provided, either by district funds or project funds, so that support will be maintained continuously for the duration of the project.
4. All new grant proposals that require spending in more than one fiscal year, shall be submitted to the Board for final approval, insofar as practical, at least 30 calendar days prior to the deadline date for making application for the project.
