Board Policy 840

PUBLIC GIFTS TO THE SCHOOLS

The Board may accept, on behalf of and for a school or the school district, any bequest or gift of money or property. The Board shall utilize such gifts in the manner designated by the donor if such designation is deemed suitable by the Board.

Each building principal shall develop building policies and guidelines that provide direction to a school group (e.g., class, organization) or non-school organization that desires to present a gift to the school. This is to ensure the gifts' appropriateness to an educational setting and shall not be interpreted as intending to discourage acts of generosity.

The Monona Grove School District shall not discriminate in the acceptance and administration of gifts, bequests, scholarships and other aids, benefits or services to students from private agencies, organizations or persons on the basis of sex, race, religion, national origin, color, ancestry, creed, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation, handicap or physical, mental, emotional or learning disability. Discrimination complaints shall be processed in accordance with established procedures.
